Update to Supplementary Regulations:

Due to updated Covid 19 Guidelines and dual occupancy now being approved by Sport Ireland, the following article in the regulations **no longer applies**. Please revert to the original ruling in Appendix 86 Art. 17 of the MI Yearbook:

“Please note all dual occupancy in competing cars is currently suspended and will only be reinstated when Covid-19 restrictions have been lifted by the HSE and government guidelines in conjunction with approval from Motorsport Ireland Council. This means class 7 competitors CANNOT carry a parent/mentor in the vehicle during practice as outlined in Appendix 86 Art. 17.”

Covid 19 Guidelines**Pre- Event:**

- Entries to be submitted and accepted online via:

- Scanned copies of completed entry forms, emailed to the Event Secretary can also be accepted. Competitors are not to bring entry forms with them on the day.
- Payment of entry fees to be completed in advance by Electronic Funds Transfer as per regulations, where possible.
- Once entries are accepted, the Event Secretary will contact the competitor and supply them electronically with a Covid 19 Self-Declaration, which must be completed fully, signed and a scanned copy or photo returned to the organisers, by email or WhatsApp, 2-3 days in advance of the event.
- One mechanic / helper allowed per entrant, who must also complete and submit a Covid-19 Self-Declaration electronically in advance of the event to the Event Secretary.
- All competitors are encouraged to download the “SPORTITY” App in advance of the event. This will be used as an online / electronic Noticeboard

No Spectators allowed & no Under 18's allowed unless competing.

All attendees are asked to bring their own PPE such as face mask / face covering & hand sanitising gel and please dispose of all waste responsibly.

Electronic Notice Board:

Mayo Autocross is using the Sportity App to assist competitors to easily access all documentation relating to the Autocross including Regulations, Final Instructions and Results etc. You will receive a push notification on your phone when any new information is published.

You need to download the free Sportity App from the App Store for I-phones or from Google Play for Android phones. When the App has been downloaded enter the following password to access the Mayo Autocross. **Password: Mayo98**

For anyone who already has the app select Add New in My Channels and enter **Password: Mayo98**

Arriving at the Event:

- On arriving at the venue a Marshal at the gate will direct attendees into a queue and separate Competitors from Marshals and Officials as they arrive.
- Marshals will, for “Contact Tracing” purposes, check competitors as they arrive to ensure they match those who have submitted entries and who have submitted a Covid-19 Self-Declaration in advance to the Event Secretary via email.
- All attending will be asked to confirm they are feeling well and will have their body temperature recorded. Everyone attending must remain in their vehicle until this is completed.
- Once the temperature check is passed, attendees will be given a wrist band to confirm so, which they must apply themselves and wear for the duration of the event.
- If anyone should fail the temperature check, they will be asked to move aside and be separated from others attending and will be re-checked again in 15 minutes. During this time they must stay in their own vehicle and not interact with others attending the event.
- If they should pass the second temperature check they will be admitted to the event as normal.
- If anyone should fail the second check then they will be asked to leave the venue on health and safety grounds and advised to go directly home without coming into contact with anyone else and contact their GP by phone for further advice. In such circumstances the entry fee will be refunded.

Delays are to be expected so everyone is asked to arrive early and co-operate with Marshals who will be there to ensure safety at all times.

Scrutineering:

- Once competition cars are unloaded, they can proceed directly to Scrutineering. Competitors are asked to please follow the direction of Marshals and Scrutineers in the area.
- Competitors only are allowed to attend scrutineering with the car, no mechanics or helpers allowed.
- Electronic scrutiny sheets will be forwarded to competitors via email and must be completed and returned in advance of the event.
- Co-operation with wearing a face mask in the scrutineering area would be appreciated.
- Social Distancing must be maintained at all times.
- Competitors are asked to open the doors, boot and bonnet of their car and lay out their logbook, helmet, race suit etc with all the labels clearly visible for inspection.
- Once their car has passed scrutineering, competitors will be given a sticker to apply to their wristband as evidence of having passed scrutineering. There will not be paper scrutineering forms on the day. **N.B.** No sticker means you will not be allowed register at the office.

Registration:

- Once a competitor has passed scrutineering, they can proceed to the office to register their entry and receive their competition numbers.
- Marshals will control the queue to the office to ensure social distancing is maintained.
- One competitor at a time will be admitted to the office.

- Competitors must show their competition licence and their wristband in order to complete registration and they will be asked to confirm their signature on the Covid 19 Self-Declaration / Indemnity Form which they have already submitted.

Drivers's Briefing:

- Briefing will be held as normal in the paddock, as it is a large outdoor area, but competitors are reminded to maintain social distancing at all times.
- Co-operation with wearing a face mask / face covering would be appreciated.
- The "SPORTITY" App will be used as an online Noticeboard for the event.

Practice Run & Timed Runs:

- Competitors will be allocated a start time for their practice run, which will be notified to them via the Sportity App and also at Sign-On. Sportity will be used as an online Noticeboard for the event.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure they are ready to start at that time.
- Competitors who are double or treble driving must ensure they take their timed runs as early as possible to avoid delays and to show consideration to other competitors.
- Competitors who are double or treble driving must sanitise their car once they complete their run. A designated area will be provided for this in the paddock. Competitors must supply their own disinfectant wipes, sprays, gloves and other PPE for this and dispose of any waste responsibly.
- Competitors are asked to remain in their Service Area as much as possible and to maintain social distancing while there.

Results:

- Results will be made available online following each timed run via the Sportity App and club Social Media pages.

Prize giving arrangements:

Awards will not be presented but will be available for collection after results are made final, taking appropriate infection control precautions.
